I believe the instructor has a solid course layout and material so that all students can be successful.

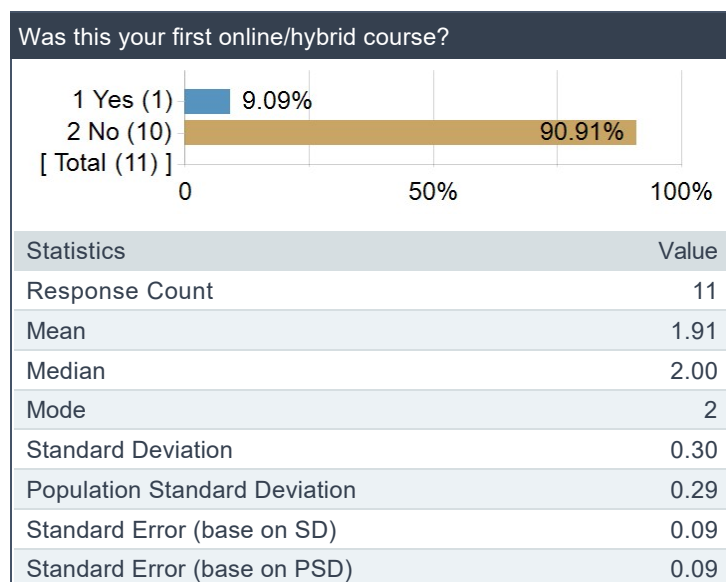
What aspects of the course were most valuable?

I loved the reading. While it was a lot, it was great when looking at different aspects of the material and content.
The instructor was very flexible and understanding with deadlines. His feedback was useful and informative. The readings – for the most part (see above) – were interesting and engaging, even if I didn't always agree with what the historians were trying to push. The primary source proposal was a good assignment – I actually plan on using the lesson I planned for that in my own teaching. I felt that every module offered something new to think about in terms of information, perspective, or interpretation.
The professor was very helpful and flexible. The feedback was given quicker than any previous class I've ever had.
I really liked the structured nature of the course where I would have some summary/analysis for each week along with practical application of the things that I learned and thought about. As a classroom teacher, this exercise in thinking about how to bring what I've learned to my students was very helpful. In fact, I am going to borrow some aspects of the organization of this course to my own classroom...knowing what I would be doing each week helped me process what I'd read and what was posted in discussions more clearly. I also liked the final assignment not being an exam, but asking me to bring the whole course together conceptually and also to discuss how this material can be used in its totality with my students. I hope the rest of the IU grad classes I take are as well done as this one!

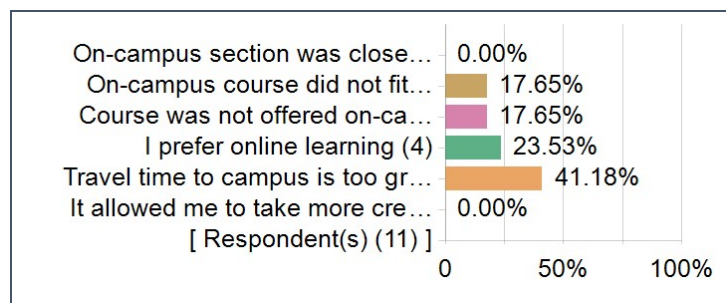

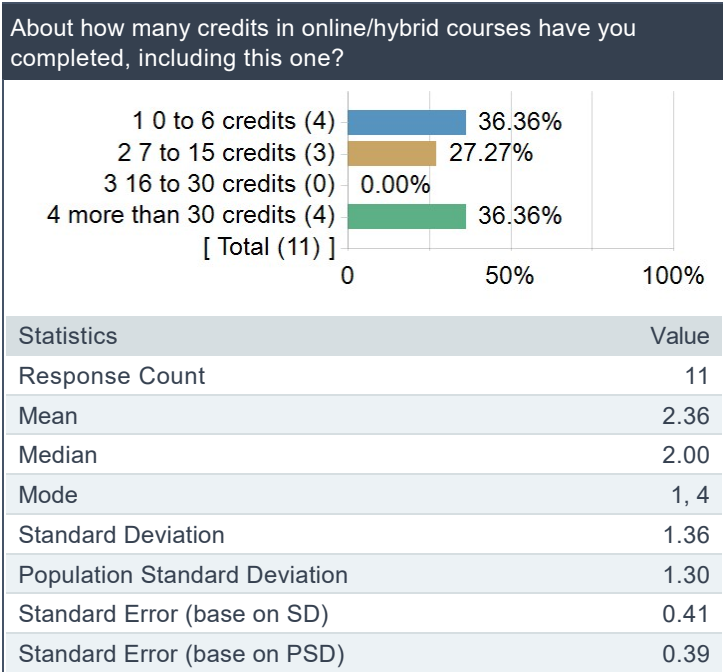
Which of the following best describes why you chose to take this course online/hybrid? [Mark all that apply].
